Any rights and remedies for breach of any such rights by any bidder or purchaser are against the Charity.
- **9.** A bid shall be taken as proof that bidders or purchasers have made themselves acquainted with the Lot in question.
- **10.** The Live Auction shall be subject to the control of the auctioneer who shall have the sole and absolute right to regulate the bidding procedure and to record the Live Auction.
- 11. Every bid shall constitute an offer to purchase the Lot at the amount bid. The auctioneer, in his sole discretion, reserves the right to withdraw a Lot without attracting any liability to any party to the Auction, including the seller, bidder or purchaser or Hauser & Wirth.
- 12. The auctioneer shall be entitled to correct any error or misunderstanding, in its sole discretion.

 13. Both the Live and Online Only Auction shall be conducted in pounds sterling (£).
- 14. No Buyer's Premium will be charged by the auctioneer.
