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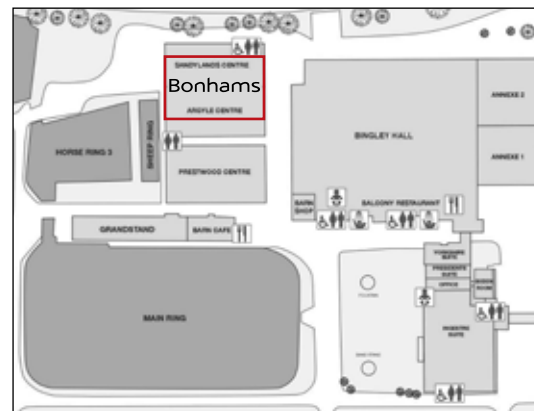

Directions to the Staffordshire County Showground

From M6 travelling North, exit at Junction 14, sign posted A518 Uttoxeter. The Staffordshire County Showground is situated on the A518 approximately 5 miles from the motorway.

Vehicle access to the Showground and the Bonhams Auction Hall

Please note, general vehicular access to the Showground and Bonhams Auction Hall is prohibited between 9am to 5pm Saturday 25 April and 9am to 4pm Sunday 26 April unless you have successfully purchased a lot. Successful buyers will be able to access Bonhams Auction Hall strictly by appointment between 2 to 5pm on Saturday 25 April and 11am to 4pm on Sunday 26 April.

Vehicular access to collect purchased lots is permissible without appointment after the latest hour on each day and until 7pm.

Buyers will need to present their purchase invoice at the Trade Gate to facilitate access.

Auction Information

This guide should be read in conjunction with our full Conditions of Sale and Important Notices sections printed in this catalogue.

Registering to Bid

All prospective bidders and buyers are required to register for the sale in order to bid. To register for the sale, please contact bids@bonhams.com / +44 20 7447 7447 or visit the sale page via our website www.bonhams.com/springstafford. Alternatively please follow the instructions on the Bidder Registration Form at the back of the catalogue. Please note that we may require additional bankers references in order to complete your registration.

Further to registering in order to bid, you will be required to provide photographic identification (passport or driving licence) and a proof of your current address, for example a utility bill or bank statement issued within the last three months. In addition, for a company registration, please submit a certificate of incorporation, showing the company's full name and registered address; documentary confirmation of each beneficial owner owning 25% or more of the company; the ID documents (such as a driving licence or passport) for the authorised signatory and where the authorised signatory is not a director, a letter on company letterhead confirming the individual's authority to act.

Methods of Bidding

In Person Bidding: Registered bidders are permitted to bid in person. After registering, you can collect a bidders paddle at our Registration Desk.

Online Bidding: Watch the auction online and submit real time bids from www.bonhams.com/springstafford

App Bidding: Download now for android and iOS.



You will be required to provide a valid credit card in your name which must be verified before you are able to place bids. If you are placing bids on behalf of a company, please ensure you indicate this when registering.

Telephone Bidding: Bid via telephone during the auction with a Bonhams|Cars representative. To ensure availability, telephone bids must be arranged 24 hours prior to the auction. Bonhams|Cars will phone the bidder several lots in advance and will execute bids upon instruction by the bidder.

Absentee Bidding: Bidders may submit an absentee bid, which is the bidder's maximum bid for a lot. After an Absentee Bid Form is completed in advance of the auction, a Bonhams|Cars' representative will execute the bid on behalf of the client, buying the lot either under or at the maximum bid and against other bidding and reserves.

Buyer's Premium

The Buyer's Premium will be 15% on the first £500,000 of the Hammer Price of each Lot, and 12% on the balance thereafter.

Buyers' attention is drawn to Condition 7 of the Notice to Bidders. VAT at the standard rate, 20%, is payable on the Premium by all Buyers, unless otherwise stated.

Damage

Any viewer who damages a Lot will be held liable for all damage caused and shall reimburse Bonhams or its agents for all costs and expenses relating to rectification of such damage.

VAT & Lots under Custom Bond

Certain symbols are used to denote that additional VAT is due on the hammer price in addition to the buyer's premium. Please refer to any symbols listed by the Lot's number against the Lot Symbols Key for additional VAT information.

In all other instances no VAT will be charged on the hammer price, but VAT at the prevailing rate (20%) will be added to the Buyer's Premium which will be invoiced on a VAT inclusive basis.

To submit a claim for refund of VAT, the local authorities require lots to be exported from the country of sale within strict deadlines. For lots on which Import VAT has been charged (marked in the catalogue with a †, * or Ω) lots must be exported within 90 days of Bonhams' receipt of payment and/or within 90 days of the date of the Sale, whichever is the earliest.

Please note it is the Buyer's responsibility to understand and adhere to any and all import or export implications in the UK or in the final country of destination. For all other lots, export must take place within 90 days of the sale date.

If you are planning to export please make the department aware.

Further export costs, duties and VAT may be applicable, depending on the country of destination. The responsibility to meet these charges rest with the buyer.

VMCC Statement of Search/Dating Certificates

The DVLA have revised their policy for the issuing of a VMCC Dating Certificate. Accordingly, any Vintage Motor Cycle Club Statement of Search Certificate issued before serial number 18999, will no longer be accepted by the DVLA for dating and registration purposes due to the insufficient depth of information provided. Whilst Bonham's may refer to old style VMCC dating certificates in the catalogue description of a lot and their physical presence within the lot's history file, the old style dating certificate cannot be relied upon as evidence in correspondence with the DVLA. In all cases, prospective bidders must satisfy themselves as to the date and manufacture of a machine and its major mechanical components prior to bidding. Ivory

Please note that from 19 January 2022, items containing ivory cannot be imported into the EU. The import of ivory into the USA is already prohibited.

Keys and Documents

Motorcycles are offered with and without keys and documents. It is the buyer's responsibility to inspect the lot at the sale to satisfy oneself as to the completeness, integrity and presence of keys, spares and documentation. The catalogue will not necessarily list such said items.

Motorcycle Frame and Engine Numbers

It is not uncommon in the life of a motorcycle for either the frame or the engine to be changed and as a consequence, the frame and engine numbers to be altered. Buyers must check by personal inspection that frame and engine numbers recorded in the catalogue description or on the registration documents correspond with those on the machine. Buyers must also satisfy themselves whether the physical number stampings on a machine are consistent with original factory stamps for that lot.

FAQs

Are there any warranties offered with the motorcycles?

No. All vehicles are offered on an 'as seen' basis. It is wise if possible to bring a professional mechanic with you to fully inspect the motorcycle. It is also advised that the motorcycle is checked before road use. The fully illustrated catalogue will describe the vehicles to the best of our ability on information supplied. Should we receive pertinent information after the publication of the catalogue, we shall affix what is known as a sale room notice (SRN) to the vehicle. A list of all SRNs will be available by the time of the auction. We are happy to offer our opinion as to the integrity of the vehicle at the sale, however you should accept this is an opinion only and should not be relied upon. In short, you should satisfy yourself as to the completeness, condition, authenticity and integrity of any lot prior to bidding. It is also important to note that some illustrations are historical and may show the vehicle in a better condition than now offered.

Can I change my mind after I have purchased a lot?

No. Lots are not sold as an option and there is no 'cooling off' period. Once the auctioneer drops the hammer a contract is made and you are obligated to proceed with the said contract.

Can I view the files that accompany the vehicles?

Yes, we should have all motorcycle files available for inspection during the view.

How fast will the auctioneer go?

The auctioneer will aim to sell circa 40 vehicles per hour.

LOT SYMBOLS KEY

Ω Omega: This Lot is from outside the UK. If this Lot is to stay in the UK, it will be subject to Import VAT at the standard rate of 20% and Import Duty at:

- 8% Import Duty+VAT if the engine size is 250cc or less
- 6% Import Duty+VAT if the engine size is more than 250cc

Both the Duty and the Import VAT are charged on the hammer price and the buyer's premium. Please see the VAT & Lots Under Customs Bond section for further information.

*** Asterisk:** This Lot is from outside the UK. If this Lot is to stay in the UK, it will be subject to Import VAT at the reduced rate of 5% on the hammer price. Please see the VAT & Lots Under Customs Bond section for further information.

† Dagger: Lots offered by a company liable to VAT and will have local VAT being applied on the Hammer Price.

N NOVA: Lots are subject to a NOVA Declaration prior to the Buyer making an application to register the vehicle in the UK with the DVLA for a V5C. Any Lot marked 'N' will not be available for immediate collection after the sale and will only be released on completion of customs clearance.

Guide for Buyers

Payment

It is of critical importance that you ensure that you have readily available funds to pay the Purchase Price and the Buyer's Premium (plus VAT and any other charges and Expenses to us) in full before making a bid for the Lot. If you are a successful Bidder, payment will be due to us by 4.30 pm on the second working day after the Sale so that all sums are cleared by the eighth working day after the Sale. Payments made by anyone other than the registered Buyer will not be accepted. Bonhams reserves the right to vary the terms of payment at any time.

It is important you are aware of the following regarding registration and payment:

The name and address in which you register will be the name and address on your invoice, if successful. We cannot amend the details on your invoice, once issued. Furthermore, when making payment, the account from which the payment is sent must match the buyer's details as per the bidder registration form and the issued invoice. We are unable to accept any third party payments. Should a third party payment be made this will result in a delay in your payment being processed and your ability to collect your purchase.

Purchases can only be released when full settlement (inclusive of all charges) of all invoices issued to the buyer is received in cleared funds.

Bonhams preferred payment method is by bank transfer.

If paying by bank transfer, the amount received after the deduction of any bank fees and/or conversion of the currency of payment to pounds sterling must not be less than the sterling amount payable, as set out on the invoice. Payment may also be made by one of the following methods:

• In-Person by Credit or Debit Card:

Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Maestro, Discover and China Union Pay (CUP) are accepted. For credit card payments the limit is £25,000. For debit card payments there is no limit if made using Chip & Pin verification.

• Telephone Payment by Credit or Debit Card (for existing customers)

Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Maestro, Discover and China Union Pay (CUP) are accepted. For credit card payments the limit is £25,000. For debit card payments there is no limit. Payment by telephone may also be accepted up to £25,000 but this option is not available for first time buyers and is subject to appropriate verification procedures. If the amount payable by you for Lots exceeds that sum, the balance must be paid by other means.

NOVA (Notification of Vehicle Arrivals) Title & Registration Documents

Certain vehicle Lots, marked 'N' are subject to a NOVA Declaration prior to the Buyer making an application to register the vehicle in the UK with the DVLA for a V5C.

Whilst the responsibility of submitting the NOVA rests with the Buyer to do so, Bonhams will facilitate the process by engaging an agent (Shippio Ltd) to undertake the NOVA and C88 (customs) application if applicable on the Buyer's behalf. A fee of £350 + VAT to do so will be added to the Buyer's invoice. If you are planning to export your purchased vehicle, please let the department know as early as possible. Please note, VAT registered buyers are responsible for submitting their own NOVA applications via the gov.uk/nova-login portal upon receiving their C88 customs clearance.

Shippio Ltd may also assist buyers with a full registration service directly which shall be charged separately to the NOVA. Please contact +44 (0) 1604 419 815 / info@shippio.com Please note, the relevant authorities generally take between 14 and 30 working days to process the NOVA and C88 Customs clearance process.

Important V5/V5C Information

In order to comply with the Driver and Vehicle Licensing agency's (DVLA) procedures for updating a change of keeper for a motor vehicle, Bonhams are obliged to notify DVLA of the purchaser's details, upon receipt of payment from the buyer.

Please note, if we have not received confirmation of the new keeper's name and address 14 days from the date of Sale, we will write to you requesting this information.

If, after 28 days from the date of Sale, we have still not had contact from you, we will update the new keeper to the name and address shown on your Bonhams invoice. Should your address be from outside the United Kingdom, we will inform the DVLA that the vehicle has been exported.

If you wish the new keeper details to be updated in any other way, please contact Harry Taylor (Motorcycle Administrator) as soon as possible (contact details on page 1 of this catalogue).

Please note: Once the V5C has been updated by the DVLA it cannot be reversed, furthermore DVLA's processing time for V5C's is 4 – 6 weeks.

Vehicles imported under Temporary Admission (TA)

Please note vehicles under TA (marked with either an Ω or a *) will not be available for registration with DVLA until customs cleared.

Vehicle Tax

For more information on taxing your vehicle, please visit www.gov.uk/vehicle-tax. You can tax the vehicle using the New Keeper Supplement (V5C/2) section of the vehicle registration certificate (V5C) online or by telephone, calling 0300 790 6802. Please note those machines offered without a V5C/2 New Keepers Supplement cannot be taxed online.

Collections

Purchases can only be released once full settlement (inclusive of all charges) of all invoices issued to the buyer is received in cleared funds, and once Lots marked 'N' have been cleared from UK Customs.

Lots marked 'N' will not be available for immediate collection after the sale and will be automatically uplifted by Shippio to Moving Motorcycle's Northamptonshire store. This is inclusive of the £350+VAT buyer charge for all Lots under Temporary Admission.

All remaining Lots (not marked 'N') must be cleared from the sale venue by 7pm Sunday 26 April. Limited collection is available Monday 27 April, 9-11am, by appointment only. Purchasers must advise Bonhams Motorcycle Department via email no later than 7pm Sunday 26 April if they intend to collect on Monday.

Any person, other than the Buyer, who should arrive to collect any purchased Lot must provide written instruction from the Buyer before Bonhams may release the Lot(s).
